University Compliance Trainings

To help you prepare for your college experience, University of the Pacific uses Vector to provide a number of engaging, online training courses for you. All incoming students are required to complete "AlcoholEdu" and "Sexual Assault Prevention." These compliance training courses are issued through a platform called Vector Solutions. Keep an eye on your Pacific email with a notification on how to join the courses. There are also two brief follow-up modules — this second part automatically becomes available after you complete the first part. The program will automatically notify you when the follow-up is available. The final deadline to have all modules completed is 11:59 p.m., PST, January 12, 2025.
